THE HELL FIRE CLUB, DUBLIN

The Hell Fire Club, established in **1735**, was a cult of lords and noblemen who would meet to summon Satan.



BALLYGALLY CASTLE, ANTRIM

2: number of ghosts known residing here – Lady Isobel Shaw and Madame Nixon.



CHARLES FORT, CORK

The White Lady is the tragic bride-to-be who still roams this **6**-pointed military fortress.



MALAHIDE CASTLE, DUBLIN

5 ghosts are known to reside at the castle, including Puck, a medieval jester.



CRUMLIN ROAD GAOL, BELFAST

17 prisoners were executed here, including an innocent American whose spirit remains.
